Lobbying any Aviation Authority Staff who are members of any committee responsible for ranking Proposals, Letters of Interest, Statements of Qualifications or Bids and thereafter forwarding those recommendations to the Board and/or Board Members is prohibited from the time that a Request for Proposals, Request for Letters of Interests, Request for Qualifications or Request for Bids is released to the time that the Board makes an award. In the event a lobbyist meets with or otherwise communicates with Staff or a Board member, including the Mayor of the City of Orlando or the Mayor of Orange County, the lobbyist shall file a Notice of Lobbying (Form 4) detailing each instance of lobbying to the Aviation Authority within 7 calendar days of such lobbying. Lobbyists will also provide a notice to the Aviation Authority when meeting with the Mayor of the City or Mayor of Orange County at their offices. Item: RFI 0404 Area 39 E-Gate & Ticket Counter Missing Circuit - COR 0117

Provide all materials, labor and equipment necessary to furnish and install all missing power circuitry requirements for the Area 39 E-Gate and ticket counter receptacles including, but not limited to, electrical raceways, conduit, supports, junction boxes, wire, core drilling and testing per the response to RFI 0404.

Add \$22,706.00

2. Item: RFIs 0458, 0564 Area 37 Roof Penetrations & Cable Tray for Antenna Array - COR 0124

Provide all materials, labor and equipment necessary to furnish and install four (4) inch conduits, cable trays, supports and sacrificial pads under roof cable trays as required for the Area 37 roof antenna mounting structure for Tenant IDF Room 02.6208 per the responses to RFIs 0458 and 0564.

Add \$12,913.00

3. Item: RFI 0704 Furred-out Wall on North side of CIP Wall for Egress Stairs at PBBs - COR 0127

Provide all materials, labor and equipment necessary to furnish and install three and one-quarter inch (3-1/4") furred walls on the north side of the cast-in-place (CIP) walls at the egress stairs and the adjacent G4, two (2) hour-rated walls in egress corridors at the passenger boarding bridges (PBBs) to align wall surfaces per the response to RFI 0704.

Add \$70,557.00

4. Item: RFIs 0540, 0543 Elevator Header F50 Light Fixture - COR 0128

Provide all materials, labor and equipment necessary to furnish and install missing type F50 light fixtures at elevator headers including, but not limited to, electrical raceways, conduit, hangers, supports, junction boxes, wire, core drilling and testing per the responses to RFIs 0540 and 0543.

5. Item: RFI 0535 Baggage Handling System Corridor Missing Exit Signs - COR 0138

Provide all materials, labor and equipment necessary to furnish and install all missing power circuitry requirements for the exit signs at the Ramp Level baggage handling system (BHS) corridor including, but not limited to, electrical raceways, conduit, hangers, supports, junction boxes, wire, core drilling and testing per the response to RFI 0535.

Add \$59,912.00

6. Item: RFI 0541 Area 36 B20 Signage Missing Circuit Designation at Y26.8 Gridline - COR 0141

Provide all materials, labor and equipment necessary to furnish and install all missing power circuitry requirements for Area 36, type B20 signage including, but not limited to, electrical raceways, conduit, hangers, supports, junction boxes, wire, core drilling and testing per the response to RFI 0541.

Add \$2,098.00

REASON FOR CHANGE:

- 1. Item: Design Omission: The BP-S00195 contract documents did not provide any information, notes, or details on electrical drawing no. E1.12.39 for the power requirements of the E-Gate and ticket counter at the Y43 column line. In the response to RFI 0404, the design team updated electrical drawing nos. E1.12.39 and E6.60.07 to provide the power circuitry requirements for the receptacles associated with this E-Gate and ticket counter.
- 2. Item: Owner Request: During the BP-S00195 P1X Gate Systems meeting with the design team, owner and contractor, the owner requested additional cable trays and roof penetrations at the Area 37 antenna array. Per the response to RFI 0458, the design team updated the contract drawings to include the cable trays and low-voltage raceway conduits from the Area 37 antenna mounting structure to Tenant IDF Room 02.6208. The design team also confirmed, per the response to RFI 0564, that the cable tray supports require sacrificial pads.
- 3. Item: Design Omission: The BP-S00195 contract documents did not indicate a finish for the north side face of the cast-in-place (CIP) exposed concrete wall for the egress stairs. Per the response to RFI 0100, the PMO stated "Exposed concrete in PBB vestibule is not acceptable". Architectural drawing no. A4.12.36 provided direction to align the north side face of the CIP wall with the adjacent six inch (6") G4, two (2) hour-rated wall of the egress corridor. Per the response to RFI 0704, the design team added furring along the north side face of the CIP wall to be continuous in the same plane with the adjacent G4 wall.
- 4. Item: Design Omission: The BP-S00195 contract documents do not show type F50 light fixtures in the header at all elevator entrances. The type F50 light fixtures are only shown at elevators 36.1 and 36.2 on the Transfer Level and elevators 35.1, 35.2, 36.1, 36.2, 38.1, 38.2, 39.1 and 39.2 on the International Level. Elevators 34.1, 37.1 and 37.2 do not have header fixtures shown except at the Transfer Level of elevator 37.1 on electrical drawing no. E1.32.37 indicating a type F98 light fixture to be installed. Per the architectural fixture schedule in specification section no. 26 50 10, the type F98 fixture is an exterior, surface-mounted fixture to be installed at elevator headers. Before Bulletin No. 7, the fixture identified at this elevator was a type F50 fixture and is also identified in the fixture schedule to be used as an elevator header light, but is an interior, recess-mounted fixture. Per the response to RFI 0540, the design team confirmed that this fixture was inadvertently changed during the Buy American Act (BAA) nomenclature update for all front of house lighting and updated drawing

nos. E1.32.35, E1.32.38 and E1.32.39 to make visible the type F50 elevator header fixtures at all landings and connect fixtures not previously shown to the adjacent life safety circuit.

- **5. Item: Design Omission:** In the BP-S00195 contract documents, life safety drawing no. A0.11.01 indicates exit signs shall be installed throughout the Ramp Level baggage handling system (BHS) corridor. However, the electrical drawings for the Ramp Level BHS corridor do not show or include power circuitry for these life safety exit signs. Per the response to RFI 0535, the design team updated electrical drawing nos. E1.31.34, E1.31.35, E1.31.36, E1.31.37, E1.31.38 and E1.31.39 to include the life safety exit sign power circuity.
- **6. Item: Design Omission:** In the BP-S00195 contract documents, electrical drawing no. E1.12.36 indicates that in Area 36 at the Y26.8 and D8 gridlines, a type B20 Signage is to be installed, but does not include a power circuitry designation. Per the response to RFI 0541, the design team updated electrical drawing nos. E1.12.36 and E6.60.06 to include type B20 signage power circuitry designated to electrical panel 7EQLRCSW1-15.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Request for Rescission of Prior Approval of 22 Lighting Fixtures from Sesco Lighting for Award 24-204-2-IFB Hyatt Lobby Renovation Design/Build and request approval of the purchase of 20 Lighting Fixtures from Contemporary Visions, LLC d/b/a Sonneman-A Way of Light for BP-00485 Hyatt Lobby Renovation Design/Build at Orlando International Airport.

BACKGROUND

On June 19, 2024, the Aviation Authority received the following bids for Bid 24-204-2 for twenty - Chandeliers responses (in alphabetical order):

On July 16, 2024, the Construction Committee approved the award for Invitation of Bid 24-204-2-IFB for Hyatt Lobby Renovation Design/Build BP-00485 – Chandeliers Rebid to Sesco Lighting Inc. as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder. The Purchase Order was issued on July 22, 2024.

ISSUES

On August 1, 2024, the Aviation Authority received a letter from Gottlieb, Rackman & Reisman, P.C. Law Firm who advised that Contemporary Visions, LLC owns the patent that covers the chosen lighting system known as the Constellation Cosmic Cube Chandeliers which was chosen by the designers Anderson Miller, LLC. The Constellation Cosmic Cube Chandelier images were utilized in the specifications attached to the referenced bid as inspiration images and some of the details were changed. After discussions with Gottlieb, Rackman & Reisman, P.C., our Legal Team advised it is in the best interest of the Aviation Authority to cancel the current Purchase Order with Sesco Lighting Inc. and enter negotiations directly with Sonneman. Per the Aviation Authority's Purchasing Policy 450.03, Non-Competitive Procurements which states Direct Negotiations following a Solicitation method requires approval by the Senior Vice President of Purchasing and Procurement in any amount. The Procurement Services

Department and the Construction Department conducted direct negotiations with Sonneman who is the provider of the Chandeliers specified in the IFB. Landreth Lighting, Inc, the Sonneman local representative but there bid was over budget at \$372,000. We were able to successfully negotiate twenty Chandeliers directly with Sonneman at a cost of \$249,999.96 which includes standard freight delivery, technical assistance during installation and custom instructions for installation. Please note that if expedited delivery and airfreight are requested, an additional cost will apply.

This request seeks approval to cancel Purchase Order 1007694 issued to Sesco Lighting Inc. in the amount of \$146,715.26 and award a Purchase Order to the Original Equipment Manufacturer, Sonneman in the amount of \$249,999.96.

SMALL BUSINESS - No Small Business participation goal due to the specialized nature of the items provided.

Funding is from previously approved Capital Expenditures Funds. Funding source verified by <u>Melvin Martinez</u> of Construction Finance on 11/08/24 as correct and available.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is respectfully requested that the Construction Committee (1) rescind its previous action to Award Solicitation 24-204-2-IFB Hyatt Lobby Renovation Design/Build BP-00485 – Chandeliers Rebid to Sesco Lighting as the lowest, responsible and responsive bidder at a not-exceed amount of \$146,715.26; (2) approval to cancel Purchase Order 1007694 issued to Sesco Lighting Inc. (3) authorize Procurement Services Department to issue a Purchase Order to Sonneman- A Way of Light for twenty Chandeliers for the total not-to-exceed amount of \$249,999.96 as shown in the table below;

On July 16, 2024, the Construction Committee approved the award for Invitation of Bid 24-204-2-IFB for Hyatt Lobby Renovation Design/Build BP-00485 – Chandeliers Rebid to Sesco Lighting Inc. as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder. The Purchase Order was issued on July 22, 2024.

ISSUES

On August 1, 2024, the Aviation Authority received a letter from Gottlieb, Rackman & Reisman, P.C. Law Firm who advised that Contemporary Visions, LLC owns the patent that covers the chosen lighting system known as the Constellation Cosmic Cube Chandeliers which was chosen by the designers Anderson Miller, LLC. The Constellation Cosmic Cube Chandelier images were utilized in the specifications attached to the referenced bid as inspiration images and some of the details were changed. After discussions with Gottlieb, Rackman & Reisman, P.C., our Legal Team advised it is in the best interest of the Aviation Authority to cancel the current Purchase Order with Sesco Lighting Inc. and enter negotiations directly with Sonneman. Per the Aviation Authority's Purchasing Policy 450.03, Non-Competitive Procurements which states Direct Negotiations following a Solicitation method requires approval by the Senior Vice President of Purchasing and Procurement in any amount. The Procurement Services

Department and the Construction Department conducted direct negotiations with Sonneman who is the provider of the Chandeliers specified in the IFB. Landreth Lighting, Inc, the Sonneman local representative but there bid was over budget at \$372,000. We were able to successfully negotiate twenty Chandeliers directly with Sonneman at a cost of \$249,999.96 which includes delivery, technical assistance during installation and custom instructions for installation.

This request seeks approval to cancel Purchase Order 1007694 issued to Sesco Lighting Inc. in the amount of \$146,715.26 and award a Purchase Order to the Original Equipment Manufacturer, Sonneman in the amount of \$249,999.96.

The proposed no-cost reallocation of funds for Addendum 48 results in a reduction of small business participation from 10% to 6%, as shown in the table below. Our analysis indicates that Ricondo & Associates, Inc. is eligible for the award of the subject amendment to Addendum 48.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Request for Approval of an Amendment to Addendum 36 to the Technology and Multi-Media Systems Specialty Engineer for the South Terminal C, Phase 1 (W-S00113) with Burns Engineering, Inc. for Additional Design and Bid Phase and Construction Administration Services for Level 5 Camera Upgrades for W-S00151 Terminal C Design and Project Oversight Services, at the Orlando International Airport.

BACKGROUND

On August 19, 2015, the Aviation Authority approved an agreement for W-S00113 with Burns Engineering, Inc. for Technology and Multi-Media Systems Specialty Engineer for the South Terminal C, Phase 1 (W-S00113) to the Aviation Authority at the Orlando International Airport, Orlando Executive Airport and other Facilities. On August 27, 2024, the Construction Committee approved Addendum No. 36 in the amount of \$42,381.00 to the above referenced agreement.

ISSUES

Consultant's proposal, dated May 28, 2024 and CCM approved on August 27, 2024, is to provide Design and Bid Phase Services. The scope of the work is to upgrade and enhance the Level 5 cameras in the BHS Interstitial level. GOAA BHS, IT and Security has requested that existing cameras be reviewed for overall coverage, and requests that cameras be relocated, changed views or additional cameras added to provide as much coverage of the Level 5 BHS platform as possible to enhance the security. Consultant will provide an overall assessment of the existing conditions for review and will then provide a full design based on the final assessment.

Since the CCM approval on August 27, 2024, there have been several changes. See the Consultant's proposal dated October 23, 2024 for details.

Burns switched one of its project resources originally thought to be a BIM Manager at \$148.00/hr. to Engineer I at \$114.00/hr. Burns is requesting a retroactive inclusion of our Engineer 1 position in the contract. Based on the difference in Rates between the two positions, an updated C Table is being submitted with a reduction to account for the rate difference.

Permitting

Burns original proposal did not include submitting drawings to the City for Permitting as that has not been a requirement on our previous projects. The C-Table has also been updated with a line item for Permitting to establish the Permit process with the City, submit the 100% signed and sealed drawings, and manage the City approval process. A permit deposit fee has been estimated at \$250.00 and included as a Not-to Exceed reimbursable.

No Changes to the current project schedule.
